75% of Kindergarten-12 schools were public and 25% were private, charter or parochial schools.


Sustained Impact



28% of participating schools and organizations attended more than one PCT event/activity.








The variety of artists and their specialty areas provide educators the chance to fill our tool kits with new skills and strategies.
