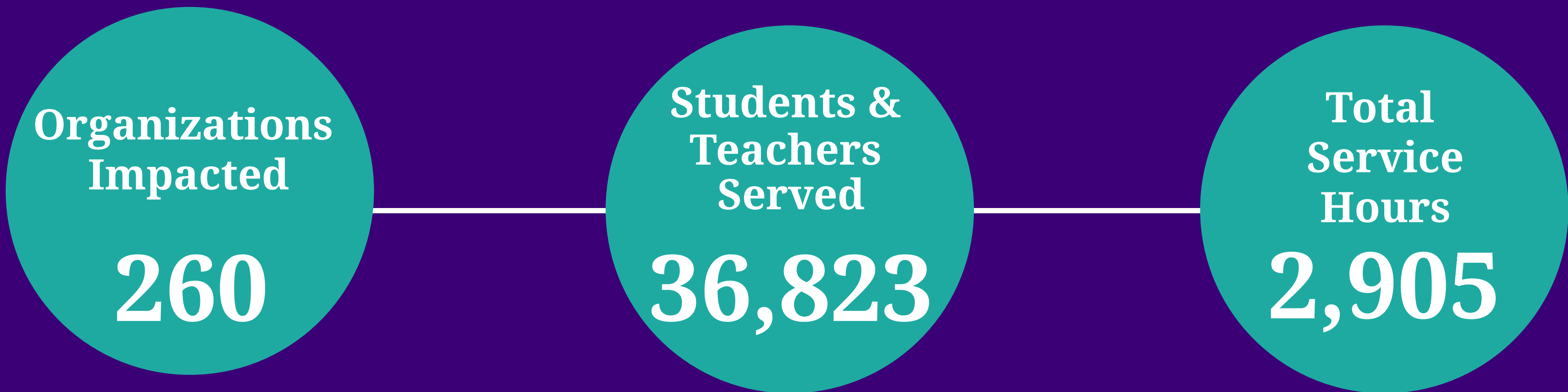
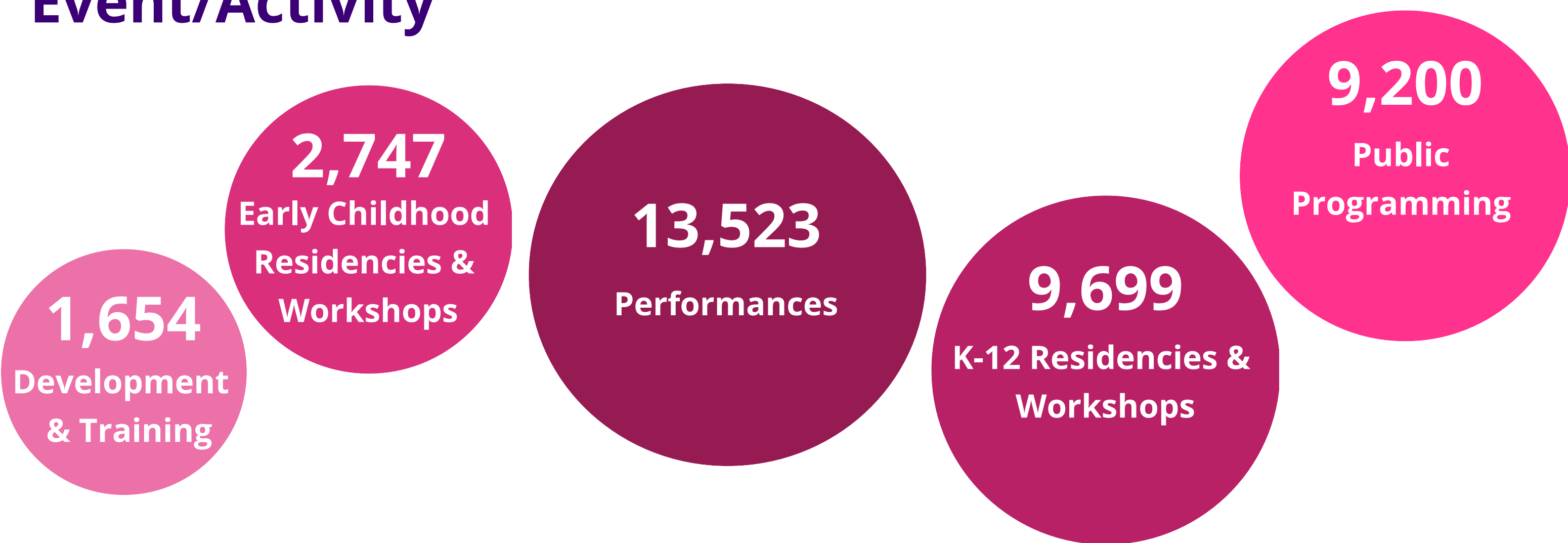

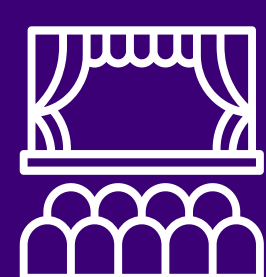
Student/Teacher Attendance by Arts Education Event/Activity

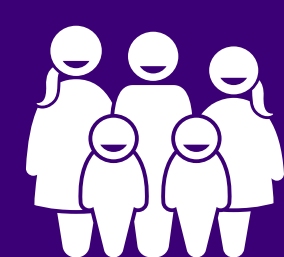
Program Highlights

13,523 students and teachers attended performances in 2024 compared to 5,404 in 2023.

↑ 150%



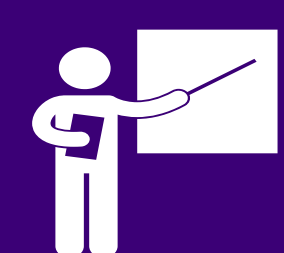
A total of 1,838 teachers and 34,985 students from 24 Early Childhood programs and 204 Kindergarten-12 schools were engaged in PCT educational programs.

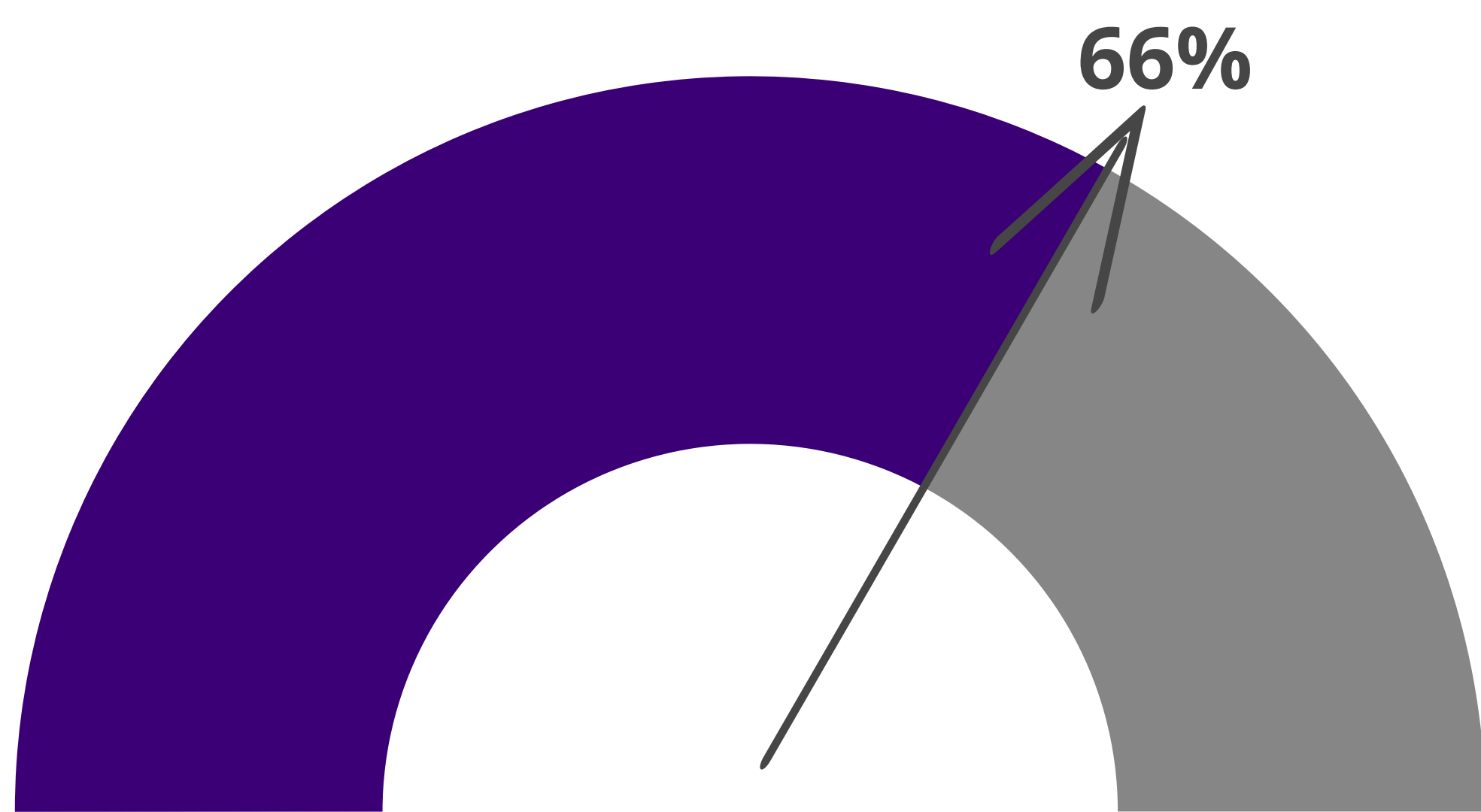


28% of participating schools and organizations attended more than one PCT event/activity.

Of the 84 public school districts and charter schools served, **over half** received Title I funds*

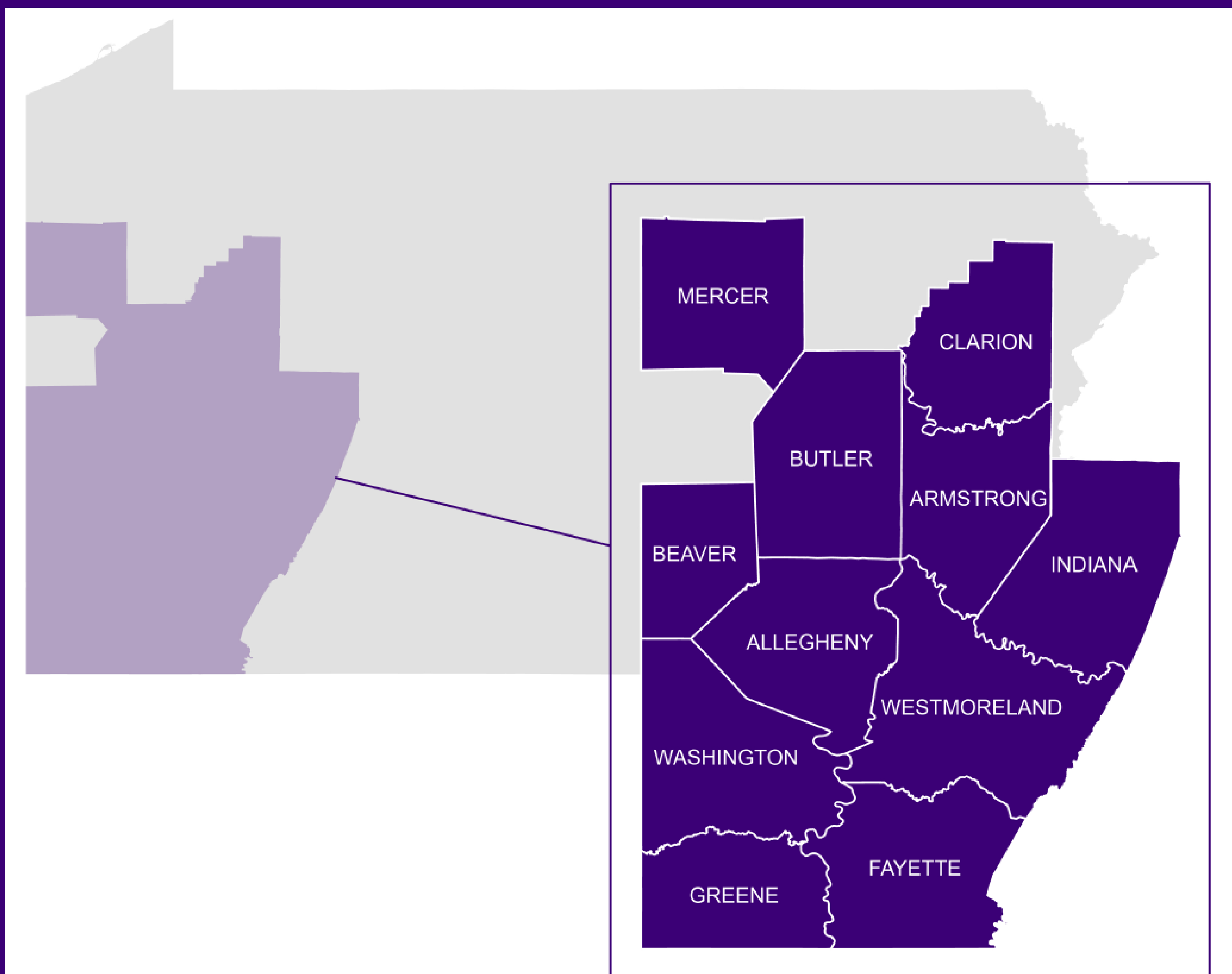

In 2024, the PCT Education Department engaged 11 counties in Southwestern Pennsylvania and 1 in Ohio
