Music Is Beauty

Aesthetic Response Activity

Step 1:

Listen to the piece "The Mestizo Waltz" from Three Latin American Dances. In the response space below, write ANY 5-7 words that come to mind. Whatever the music makes you think of! You can write these words in any size, style or direction. Use the whole space.

Step 2:

With your eyes closed, listen to the piece again. What colors do you hear in the music? Using crayons or markers, add the colors you hear in the response space, between the words you have written down. Do you hear any repeating patterns or designs?

Step 3:

Listen to the piece a third time. This time think about what visuals come to mind. Draw or doodle what you imagine in any part of the response space – between, around, or on top of the words and colors that are already there!

What Did We Just Do?

There are many different forms of **beauty**. They include art, music, dance, and nature. All forms of beauty make us feel something. Sometimes we can **talk** about how something beautiful makes us feel. Sometimes we can only express our reaction without words, through things like **dance**, **drawing**, **doodles**, **or colors**. All these reactions are called **aesthetic response**. Everyone's response will be different because everyone experiences beauty differently. There is no right or wrong way to respond!

Reflection Questions

1) What did it feel like to do this activity?

2) Look at what you created in the response space. How well does it show how the music made you feel?

3) What other ways could you show an aesthetic response to this music?
