Registration

Tuition, Payment, and Reimbursement

Fee to participate is \$125 per student. Tuition must be paid in full by April 4th, 2014. Cancellations from the program may be made until January 21, 2017 with a \$25 cancellation fee. Cancellations after May 27, 2016 are non-refundable.

Camp Broadway's teaching staff are theater professionals from the Broadway community, hired by the Pittsburgh Cultural Trust to work with your campers. They have years of experience directing, choreographing, and teaching students at various New York colleges and universities. Their acting, singing, and dancing credits include, but are not limited to, roles in the original Broadway productions of *42nd Street*, *Me and My Girl*, *City of Angels*, *My Fair Lady*, *Cabaret*, *Crazy for You*, *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers*, *A Chorus Line*, and *The Producers*.

Schedule and Location

Check-in will be located in the Trust Arts Education Center from 8:30am – 9am. Please give yourself ample space to find the venue and parking. Enter the Trust Arts Education Center on Liberty Avenue. There will be someone on hand to guide you. Parents can either drop their student(s) off, or park and accompany them to the check-in table. Parents may stay in downtown between check-in and the performance, but we do not have space to accommodate anyone other than the students. There are many coffee shops, galleries, shopping, restaurants, and a small movie theater within walking distance from the Trust Arts Education Center.

9am-5pm | Camp Schedule

Detailed schedules of the daytime activities will be handed out at check-in. The campers will move from group classes to vocal and acting workshops that are divided by age group. Lunch will be served from 12:30pm – 1pm, and the afternoon will be rehearsal preparing campers for the culminating performance.
