

**2005 Schneider,  
Niersteiner Hipping  
Riesling**

Aromas of peaches and apricot mingle with mineral and citrus notes. Flavors of green apple and apricot give the wine good acidity that complements the peach palate.

**2004 Quinta  
da Cortezia,  
Touriga Naçional**  
With a nose of plum and blackberry, this wine tastes of cassis, blackberry, plum with notes of minerals and tobacco leaf and a chocolate finish.

**2005 Louis Jadot  
Pinot Noir**  
With plump red berries and toasty, earthy notes on the nose, this red benefits from decanting as rich blackberry flavors become more pronounced.

**2004  
Water Wheel  
Cabernet Sauvignon**  
This wine has a violet color and blackcurrant aromas with a hint of mint. The palate is full of mulberry flavors with hints of vanilla, oak and mint on the finish.
