The Antinori Family - Tuscany

2017 Villa Antinori Toscana Bianco

Since 1385, the Antinori Family has been committed to the art of winemaking. Over six centuries and twenty-six generations long, the Antinori family has managed the business directly with innovative and sometimes bold decisions. e ways maintaining a fundamental respect for They are one of the biggest wine companies in Italy, and their innovations played a large part in the "Super-Tuscan" revolution of the 1970s. It is the 10th oldest family owned company in the world.

Villa Antinori Bianco is one of the historic wines of the Antinori family. It was produced for the first time by Niccolò Antinori in the 1931 vintage and since then the label has remained virtually unchanged, as has the production philosophy, oriented towards representation of the wine's source, the place where its grapes are cultivated.

Tasting Notes:

The nose, fruity and floral, offers much finesse and elegance with notes of bananas, pineapple, white flowers, and candied fruit. The palate is balanced with savory mineral notes on the finish and aftertaste.

2018 Three Wives Germaine Gabrielle Pinot Noir Rosé

Remy Drabkin knew she wanted to be a winemaker at 8 years old. By 14 she was working her first grape harvest and by 17, with three harvests under her belt, she was studying winemaking abroad. Remy's Old World Style philosophy developed under the guidance of Oregon wine industry pioneers and the Italian families around which she was raised.

Named for Remy's Grandmother, **Germaine Gabrielle** honors a woman who embodies the spirit of pink! It is an Estate grown Pinot Noir from the Lone Madrone Vineyard, barrel fermented in neutral barrels with champagne yeast and daily lees stirring.



Tasting Notes:

A nose of fresh nectarines and peach blossoms.

2017 Domaine Joseph Drouhin-Laforet Pinot Noir Bourgogne

Véronique Drouhin-Boss, the fourth-generation winemaker of the Drouhin family, oversees the winemaking at Maison Joseph Drouhin in Burgundy, producing some of the world's finest Pinot Noir and Chardonnay wines on both sides of the Atlantic.

Véronique's interest in wine and the family business began when she was young, and blossomed under the tutelage of father Robert Drouhin.

Tasting Notes:

Full of charm: bright ruby color and a nose rich with aromas of red fruit (raspberry, red currants, wild strawberry). On the palate, the wine is pleasant, fruity and refreshing, with light tannins and great elegance.

2015 Wines Of Illyria Vranac (vrah-natz)

Wines of Illyria is a wine import and distribution company formed in 2014 by Indira Bayer, a native of Yugoslavia who immigrated to the US in 1996.

Her company deals in wines from Bosnia and Herzegovina.

This particular wine is made of 100% Vranac, a kingpin grape of the Herzegovina wine region, closely related to Zinfandel and Primitivo.

Tasting Notes:

Fresh acidity and discreet fruitiness. Light scents of violet and a hint of wisteria mark the nose. Notes of plum, blackberry and a pinch of saltiness – a balanced and pleasant wine for everyday drinking.
