

BEHOLD THE BOLD UMBRELLAPHANT

Let's Make New Words!

In the book *Behold the Bold Umbrellaphant*, author Jack Prelutsky blends words to create fantastical new creatures, like:

UMBRELLA + ELEPHANT = UMBRELLAPHANT

A blended word overlaps the sounds from two words to create a new word. An example of a blended word is: Spoon + Fork = SPORK.

Prelutsky also uses special words called compound words to describe some of his new creatures. A compound word combines two whole words. An example of a compound word is: Snow + Ball = SNOWBALL.

What words can you make?

Look for examples of compound words and blended words in Behold the Bold Umbrellaphant. Then try making some of your own!

Shoe + Horn = SHOEHORN	Shoehorn + Hornet = SHOEHORNET
