Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra Announces 2025 Summer with the Symphony

Programming includes Nas, Juneteenth, Fiddlesticks in Your Neighborhood, favorites from the movies, and more

PITTSBURGH — Today, the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra (PSO) announced its 2025 Summer with the Symphony programs, which include Nas: Illmatic Live with the PSO, a Juneteenth concert at Mellon Park, its free annual Americana concert at Soldiers & Sailors Memorial Hall, Fiddlesticks in Your Neighborhood, and a concert of classical favorites from the movies, Mad About the Movies. These join an existing summer lineup that features The Lord of the Rings: The Fellowship of the Ring, Marvel's Infinity Saga Concert Experience, and Joe Hisaishi Conducts the PSO, among others.

"This summer, the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra has something for everyone," said **Melia Tourangeau, President & CEO**, "whether it's Howard Shore's unforgettable music in *The Lord of the Rings* or the rhythms of Nas, to family-friendly favorites like Fiddlesticks in Your Neighborhood and classics from the movies in Mad About the Movies. I invite audiences of all ages and tastes to experience and remember the PSO this summer."

The Heinz Hall Presents series also announced **Frankie Valli & the Four Seasons: The Last Encores** at Heinz Hall on July 20, and two rentals: <u>Wilco</u> and <u>TwoSet Violin</u>. Tickets for these are available now. More free summer concerts in the Pittsburgh community will be announced in the coming weeks.

Nas: Illmatic Live with the PSO – July 26

Experience the fusion of hip-hop and classical music as Nas joins the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra on July 26 at Heinz Hall. Renowned for his seminal debut album *Illmatic*, Nas will perform its tracks as a part of the NAS Illmatic 30 Year Anniversary Tour alongside the PSO for a unique blend of rap and orchestral music.

After *Illmatic*, Nas went on to release 14 albums, 8 of which are multi-platinum and platinum, including *Nastradamus, Stillmatic, God's Son,* and *Street's Disciple*. With 16 GRAMMY nominations, Nas released *King's Disease* in 2020, giving Nas his first GRAMMY win for Best Rap Album. A legendary hip hop mogul, co-founder of Mass Appeal Records, actor, and executive producer, Nas' extensive catalog speaks for itself.

Nas: Illmatic will have a presale beginning April 23 and will be available to the public April 25. A VIP package is available which includes premium seating, early entry, and exclusive Illmatic 30th Anniversary merchandise, available at pittsburghsymphony.org.

The Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra is proud to participate in Pittsburgh's 2025 WPA Juneteenth and Black Music Celebration with an outdoor concert on Wednesday, June 19 from 5:00 to 6:00 PM at Mellon Park. Led by Principal Pops Conductor Byron Stripling, the program will feature a lively big band set that showcases members of the PSO brass alongside regional jazz musicians and will include special appearances by vocalist Sydney McSweeney and Bobby Floyd playing the Hammond B3 organ.

On July 3, join the Pittsburgh Symphony for its free annual Americana Concert centered around American music in tribute to our military personnel and veterans. Featuring music from *Lincoln* by John Williams, Tchaikovsky's *1812 Overture*, the songs of the armed forces and more, this star-spangled program led by Associate Conductor Jacob Joyce and vocalist Katy Williams is performed in Oakland's Soldiers & Sailors Memorial Hall.

Fiddlesticks In Your Neighborhood – July 12 & 13

Fiddlesticks returns to Moon and Mars High Schools this summer for a new adventure with vocalist Katy Williams, conductor Moon Doh, and the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra. Meet Fiddlesticks, the PSO's seven-foot tall, cuddly feline friend who loves to dance, clap, and celebrate music with his friends in the neighborhood. Held at Moon and Mars High Schools on July 12 and 13 respectively, this summer's program—Fiddlesticks' Favorite Things—invites friends of Fiddlesticks new and old to sing, dance, and discover the magic of music together.
