




Wait, Wait, Where's the Orchestra?

7.	The largest instrument with a bell
8.	Louis Armstrong played this instrument (and sometimes sang to sound like it too!)
9.	Can be upright or electric
10.	Yo-Yo Ma played this instrument on Sesame Street and Mister Rogers' Neighborhood

11. Tł	he alto voice of the string family
 12. O	riginally used for hunting calls, especially in France
13. Tl	he same instrument as Clue 1, with a different part to play
– 14. Tł	he only single reed instrument in the orchestra
– 15. Pl	lays the role of grandfather in Peter and the Wolf
— 16. Ті	unes the orchestra with its 'A'
— 17. Ро	op singer Lizzo plays this instrument (once she played a crystal one)
— 18. С	entral to the orchestra yet doesn't make a sound
