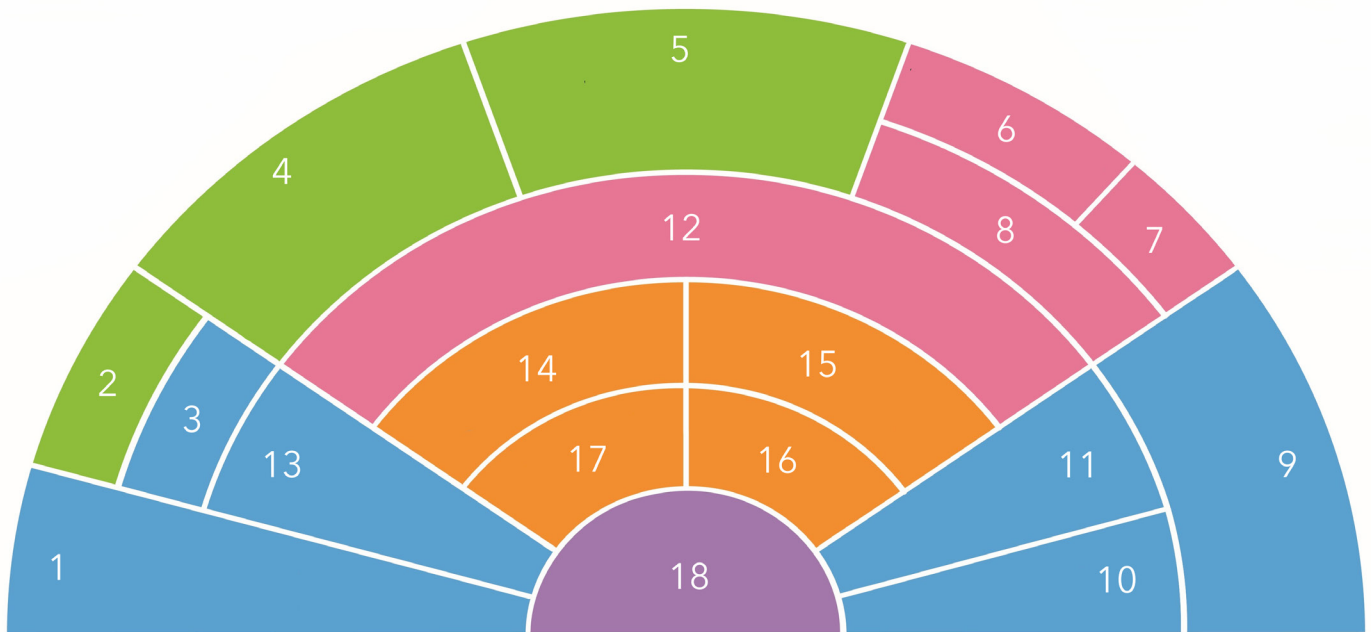




Wait, Wait, Where's the Orchestra?

3. Two hands play its 47 strings

4. Group of instruments that you strike, shake, or scrape

5. Bowl-shaped instrument that can sound like rolling thunder

6. The only brass instrument with no valves

7. The largest instrument with a bell

8. Louis Armstrong played this instrument (and sometimes sang to sound like it too!)

9. Can be upright or electric

10. Yo-Yo Ma played this instrument on Sesame Street and Mister Rogers' Neighborhood

11. The alto voice of the string family

12. Originally used for hunting calls, especially in France

13. The same instrument as Clue 1, with a different part to play

14. The only single reed instrument in the orchestra

15. Plays the role of grandfather in Peter and the Wolf

16. Tunes the orchestra with its 'A'

17. Pop singer Lizzo plays this instrument (once she played a crystal one)

18. Central to the orchestra yet doesn't make a sound...
