

Program Highlights

% Change Compared to 2024



12,429 students and teachers participated in K-12 Residencies and Workshops.

↑ 28%



113 teaching artists led 384 arts education events/activities.

↑ 24%



15,319 students and teachers attended performances in 2025 compared to 13,523 in 2024.

↑ 14%



290 schools and organizations participated in PCT Education Department events in 2025 compared to 260 in 2024.

↑ 12%



A total of 2,882 teachers and 35,320 students from 21 Early Childhood programs, 211 Kindergarten-12 schools, and 58 community organizations engaged in PCT educational programs.

↑ 4%



77% of Kindergarten-12 schools were public and 23% were private, charter, or parochial schools.




27% of participating schools and organizations attended more than one PCT event/activity.

Of the 84 public school districts and charter schools served, **over half** received Title I funds*


