PITTSBURGH PUBLIC THEATER LIGHTS UP THE HOLIDAYS WITH A CHRISTMAS STORY

The iconic story comes to hilarious life on November 30. Extended by Popular Demand Through December 23

November 25, 2022 • Pittsburgh, PA — Pittsburgh Public Theater is celebrating the holiday season with an all-new stage production of Philip Grecian's *A CHRISTMAS STORY*. The play will delight audiences from November 30 to December 23 at the O'Reilly Theater. Five performance were added to meet demand. Directed by Michael Berresse, the original story is based on Jean Shepherd's novel *In God We Trust, All Others Pay Cash* and the iconic 1983 film written by Shepherd, Leigh Brown, and Bob Clark. *A CHRISTMAS STORY* is presented by PNC, and the Production Sponsor is Richard W. Moriarty, MD.

In this timeless comedy, nine-year-old Ralphie Parker takes the audience on a hysterical, hijinks-filled avalanche of adventure filled with all the trappings of a perfect family holiday – an exploding furnace, a Little Orphan Annie decoder pin, an innocent experiment with a wet tongue on a cold lamppost, and a wild rash of theatrical fantasies not for the "fra-gee-lay" of heart. The movie has delighted audiences for more than 40 years, and the stage version is further evidence that Shepherd's account of his 1940s upbringing in the Midwest is not just a Christmas story, it's the Christmas story.

"Few things in life are as nostalgic and evocative as the memory of childhood holidays," director Berresse said. "The sights and smells of a cherished home and family traditions and that one special gift we just had to have. In bringing the hilarious and much-loved classic *A CHRISTMAS STORY* to Pittsburgh Public Theater, we invite the entire family to come share in the magic of old radio shows, first crushes, and the kid that's alive and well in all of us."
